Exams that focus on the pelvis and abdomen may no longer need lead shields.

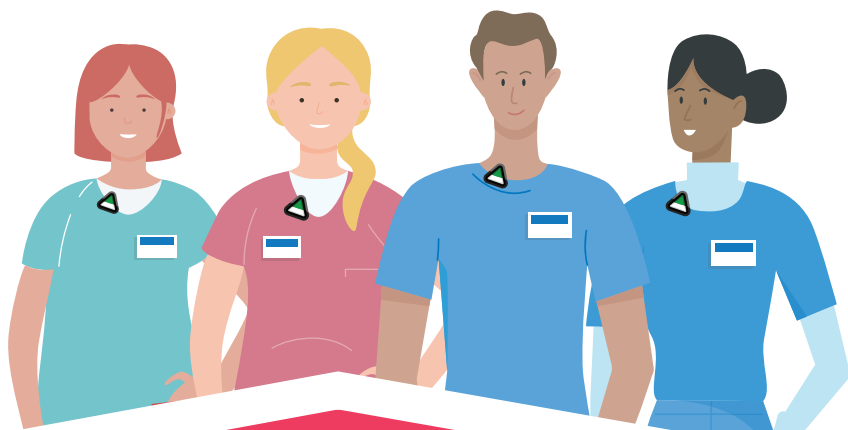
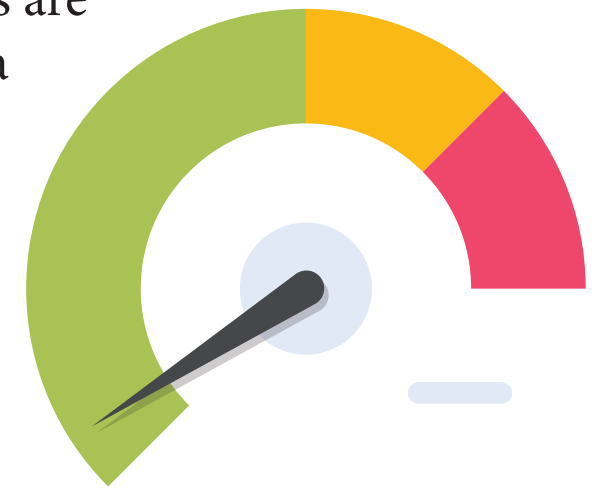


Why?

Because lead shields block x-rays, anything covered by the shield can't be seen on radiographic images.



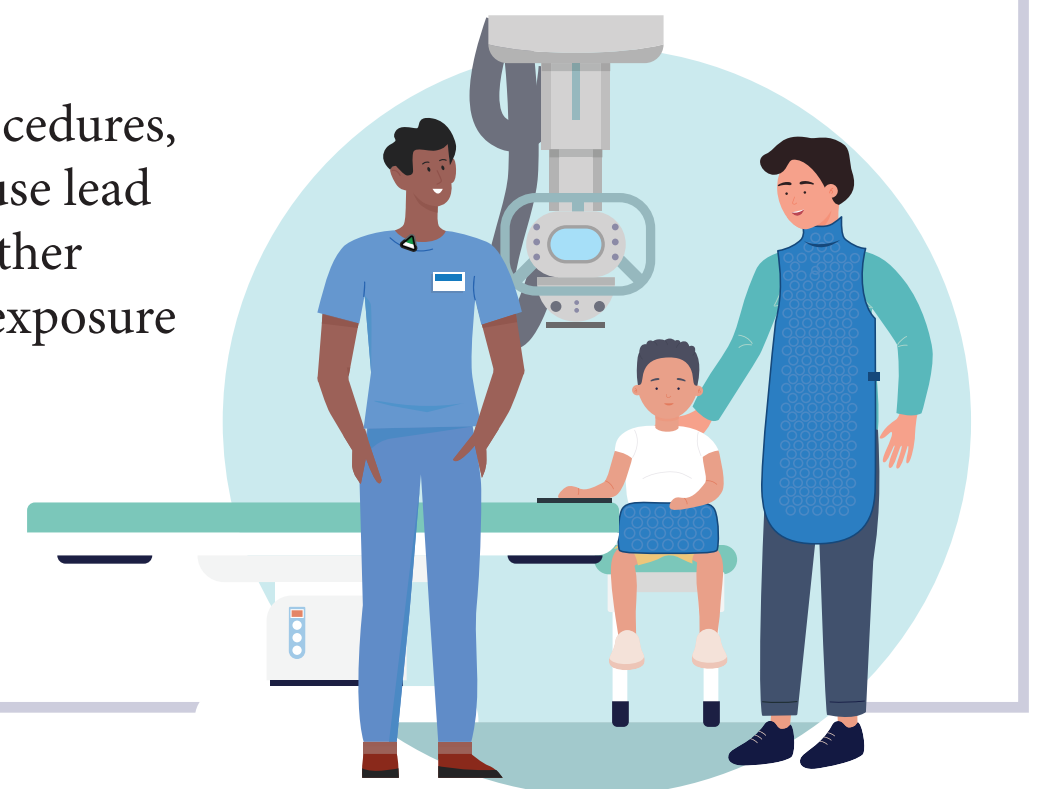
The imaging equipment we use today is much safer than older equipment, and most of our exams are performed using a very low amount of radiation.



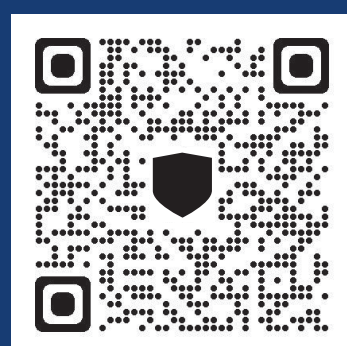
Your Best Shield Is The Radiologic Technologist
